FORMAT OF PLAY: The Fifteenth Annual Senior Care Golf Tournament is a traditional four player scramble. The team will select the best shot of the group and each team member will hit from within one club length of the spot. This is repeated until the ball is holed out. To ensure pace-of-play, a maximum score of double bogey is recorded for each hole. If double bogey is reached, pick up the ball and proceed.

CARTS: Please follow golf cart rules and utilize cart paths near tees and greens. Repair ball marks, divots,

and rake sand. Return your cart to the clubhouse as directed after you have unloaded your clubs.

SCORING: Please add up your scorecard and turn it in to The Wilds staff at bag drop hut returning

carts to vertical.

PRIZES: Trophies to 1-3 places and prizes for contest hole winners.

Drive for Dough Hole 17, \$100 cash to Men & Women winners.

MULLIGANS: Can be purchased at the start of the event in the registration area for \$5 each. Maximum of 4 per

team. Mulligans cannot be used on contest holes or par 3 holes. Honor system is in play.
